High School Application Process

The below application is for current sophomores and juniors who are interested in attending a high school program at Locklin Technical College in the 21-22 school year. The completed application should be ***typed, saved to your computer, then emailed as an attachment*** to Amanda Coleman at Locklin Technical College at ColemanA@santarosa.k12.fl.us no later than **May 7, 2021**. *Please note, we are accepting the application by email only at this time.*

The student, parent, and counselor will receive an email confirmation within 3 school days of submitting the application stating it was received by Mrs. Coleman. If they do not receive a confirmation, please email ColemanA@santarosa.k12.fl.us or call Mrs. Coleman at 850-983-5700 Ext. 293 to follow up on the receipt of your application.

Once eligibility is determined and decisions are made for acceptance/denial into each program, notification will be sent by email in mid-July to all student applicants, parents, and counselors. The student/parent will be requested to reply to the message to confirm receipt of the email and intent to attend Locklin in the upcoming school year.

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for any Dual Enrollment program students must be entering the 11th or 12th grade, have a least a minimum 2.0 unweighted GPA, be on track for high school graduation, and meet the basic skills requirement for the program of interest. Additionally, students projected to graduate from high school before the scheduled completion date of a post-secondary course may not register for that course through Dual Enrollment.
